You need not limit your search to these activities.

- Fill out a complete, accurate, and relevant job application on **www.WorkInTexas.com** and use the reemployment services at your local Workforce Solutions Center.
- · Complete job applications in person or online with employers who have suitable openings.
- Mail job applications and resumes to employers who are advertising open positions.
- · Talk with employers who have job openings.
- · Interview with employers in person or on the phone.
- · Register with private employment agencies or placement services.
- Use resources at your local Workforce Solutions Center to:
 - Learn about the local labor market
 - Asses your skills for job matching
 - Participate in job workshops
 - Dobtain and follow up on job referrals
 - Develop new job leads
- · Attend job search seminars, job club meetings, job fairs, or employment-related workshops.
- Use online job matching systems to submit applications and resumes, search for matches, request referrals, and apply for jobs.
